Approximately 90% of this property can be flooded and managed for migratory waterfowl. There are no government contracts restricting the use of this land. There is also opportunities with a lodge site to build if desired.

Historically, prior to development, duck hunting on this property produced birds as well as large deer and in recent years waterfowl hunting has improved dramatically with proper access and infrastructure.




Aerial Map





Aerial Map









